



Multi-family Water Saving Tips

These are suggestions on ways to save water in multi-family residential buildings.

For Owners

Educate tenants about water saving practices and how much impact the entire building can have if everyone participates.

Here are some easy ways to save water:

- Install **faucet aerators** in all units
- Install **low-flow showerheads** in all units
- Install **high-efficiency toilets**
- Install **high-efficiency clothes washers**
- Install **high-efficiency dish washers**
- Schedule **regular maintenance evaluations**
- **Encourage tenants to report leaky faucets and toilets**
- **Repair leaks** immediately

Don't Forget About Landscaping!

- Install **drought-tolerant landscaping with drip irrigation**
- **Water landscaping in the early morning or evening** according to the appropriate schedule
- **Repair sprinklers to avoid runoff or overspray**
- **Remind landscaping staff to never hose off hardscape**
- **Use mulch around plants** to avoid evaporation and keep weeds to a minimum
- **Remove weeds** and other unwanted plants to save water for the plants you want to keep
