The enclosed Cost Estimate for January 21, 2018 Gospel Concert provides the estimated out-of-pocket costs for The Wallis services in connection with the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary gospel concert sponsored by the City in conjunction with the Faithful Central Bible Church of Inglewood. City Council liaisons requested that this item be included on the next Wallis Annenberg Committee agenda during Study Session on November 7, 2017.

3	3 Security equipment City could install new security camera system, or City could access systems already installed by tenant.						
4	Security staffing	TBD, the recently completed security audit could inform needs and their value.					
5	5 Annualized building systems replacement costs Annualized capital cost for replacement of all building per a replacement schedule based on estimated useful depreciation. The intent is that tenant could hand off a functional building to City at end of lease term in 2068
